Carroll Township Street Tree Removal Policy

6-14-2024

Background:

Trees are a natural resource and improve air quality, lower air temperature, reduce storm water runoff, raise property values, and contribute to the aesthetics of neighborhoods within the Township. As such, Carroll Township has a Street Tree Removal Policy that regulates the removal of required trees within the Township. This Policy requires that prior to removal of any required tree; the property owner shall acquire a Street Tree Removal Permit. The fee for the tree removal permit is \$25.00.

When A Tree Removal Permit is Required:

A Street Tree Removal Permit is required to remove any tree previously required to be planted as part of a subdivision / land development project. Required trees are defined as:

 Street trees (installed within the public right-of-way as required under previous Township Ordinance)

Conditions for Street Tree Removal:

Although street trees provide an aesthetic streetscape, the Township recognizes that these trees can also become a nuisance in some cases. For that reason, the Township may issue permits for others to remove trees, based on the following conditions:

- Hazardous Trees. Trees that are determined to be a hazard by virtue of conditions including, but not limited to, significant/frequent limb breakage, a majority of decayed, dead, or damaged foliage, branches, trunk or roots, and the distinct danger of a tree or tree part falling with a high potential to hit a target (person, structure, vehicle, utility, other valuable landscape feature) shall be removed.
- <u>Dead and Dying Trees</u>. Street trees that are dead or have been determined to be in a state of severe decline, shall be removed.
- <u>Diseased/Insect Infected Trees</u>. Public trees that have a disease or are infested with an
 insect that is known or declared to be an imminent threat to other trees in the Township
 and the region shall be removed.
- <u>Emergency Removals</u>. Healthy trees may be removed if an emergency situation exists and tree removal is the only option to address the issue, such as in the case of a broken water or sewer line.
- Unsafe Condition Removals. If it is determined by the Township that a tree is causing a serious visibility hazard, such as blocking a traffic light or sign, or visibility of oncoming

- traffic, then it shall be removed. Removal is only warranted when proper pruning will not correct the issue for a reasonable length of time, as determined by the Township.
- Invasive Species. Tree(s) is on the list of invasive species as designated by the PA
 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
- Other Removals. Other situations where street tree removal is warranted may include the following:
 - Hardscape / Structural Damage. If sidewalk, curb, road, driveway, or other hardscape features are being damaged by the roots of the street tree, then a healthy tree can be considered for removal.
 - O Township Projects. If a tree is in conflict with and needs to be removed to accommodate the construction of a public improvement, or to achieve a goal of the Township, then it will be permitted for removal.

Process:

- Provide a completed Street Tree Removal Permit Application to the Township along with the \$25.00 permit fee. The application MUST be signed by the owner of the property.
- It is the permit applicant's responsibility to bear all costs associated with the tree and stump removal.
- The applicant is responsible for locating underground utilities and must complete a PA One Call request prior to tree / stump removal.
- All disturbed areas associated with the tree removal must be restored to lawn.
- The applicant must install new shade trees (equal to the number of street trees removed)
 elsewhere on the property meeting current Shade Tree Ordinance requirements (§435-52.D)
 OR demonstrate that additional trees have previously been planted that meet the current
 ordinance requirements.
